New Business	<p>Review of April Meeting Minutes: Mr. Jacky Betts made a motion to accept the minutes with a second from Mr. Michael Ellard. Approved without opposition.</p> <p>Emergency Response Guide Project: Mrs. Laura Pressler handed out an example of the Emergency Response Guides and fielded questions regarding the standardized hospital codes within the guide, their functional use, and the estimated costs of the guides. Mr. Comer noted that the Coalitions would seek alternate funding for the Emergency Response Guides and that this is a project that would take up to a year to complete. Mr. Espinoza noted that this would be a great tool to complement all facilities Emergency Preparedness Programs. Mr. Comer noted that he would follow-up with members to get an estimate on how many guides each organization would need.</p> <p>MOAB Training: Mrs. Laura Pressler and Mr. Steve Beggs discussed the opportunity to sponsor the MOAB 3-day Instructor Course in Wichita Falls. Cost of the course is estimated to be \$1,700 per participant. Mr. Espinoza noted that the MOAB training would meet the training requirements stipulated by the CMS Conditions of Participation.
